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2. GENERAL OBJECTIVE

Implement control measures for the protection of collaborators who will continue working during the selective isolation stage with responsible individual distancing established and described in Decree 206 of February 26, 2021, Resolution 00223 of February 25, 2021.

2.1. SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- ÿ Describe the guidelines to prevent the spread of the virus (Covid-19) in the processes and work areas.
- ÿ Determine entry protocol for external personnel such as: suppliers and collaborators.

3. SCOPE

All work spaces and common areas or access to people.

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4. DEFINITIONS

CONTAGION: Transmission of a disease by contact with the pathogenic agent that causes it.

COVID-19: Recently discovered, it causes a respiratory infection (SARS), most people (about 80%) recover without any special treatment.

EPIDEMIC: Disease that attacks a large number of people or animals in the same place and during the same period of time.

PPE: Individual Protection Elements.

WHO: World Health Organization.

PANDEMIC: Epidemic of a disease or other health condition that occurs in a large area (several countries or continents) and usually affects a considerable part of the population.

BIOLOGICAL RISK: It is defined as the possible exposure to microorganisms that can give rise to diseases, motivated by work activity.

SG-SST: Occupational Health and Safety Management System.

WORKER WITH INTERMEDIATE EXPÓSURE RISK: This group includes those

employees who may have contact or exposure to a suspected or confirmed case in a work environment in which transmission from one person to another can occur due to their close proximity.

VECTORS: It is the pathogenic organism of an infected carrier, animal or human, and transmits it either to an intermediate carrier or directly to a human carrier.

Transfer occurs directly through bites, stings, or tissue infection, or indirectly through disease transmission. In the specific case of COVID-19, the vector is the human who has the capacity to transmit the virus by contact with it.

VIRUS: Microorganism composed of genetic material protected by a protein shell, which causes various diseases by entering a cell as a parasite to reproduce in it.

5. RESPONSIBILITIES

THE EMPLOYER:

1. Create disinfection protocols for people who for reasons of force majeure must provide special services that require entering the facilities or work area.

2. Create the disinfection point with the required supplies (water, soap, alcohol, hypochlorite (or similar), PPE).

3. Verify that when external personnel enter the facilities, they comply with the minimum protocols of: hand washing.

4. Establish timely communication channels for the notification of suspected COVID-19 cases.

5. Determine communication route for reporting by employees of possible cases of COVID-19.

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6. Implement protocols, procedures and guidelines in relation to the preparation, response and care of cases of illness by COVID-19.

7. Implement the recommendations by the ARL for preparation, response and care in cases of illness by COVID-19.

8. In work positions where there may be a higher risk of contact with suspected or confirmed cases of COVID-19, they must: identify, prevent and control the risk, as well as apply the prevention and control measures adopted in accordance with the hierarchy scheme established in article 2.2.4.6.24 of Decree 1072 of 2015.

9. Provide individual protection elements according to the specific recommendations in accordance with the guidelines defined by the Ministry of Health and Social Protection for the prevention of contagion.

10. Reinforce cleaning, prevention and self-care measures in all the processes of Hospedería Duruelo.

11. Require the cleaning of work surfaces, equipment, tools and work devices frequently used by employees.

12. Require employees not to share individual protection elements.

13. Have the necessary resources to implement the measures contained in this action plan.

HEAD OF THE WORKPLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM.

- 1. The company will update the Hazard Identification, Evaluation and Risk Assessment (IPEVR) matrix, including the risk of exposure to COVID-19.
- 2. Verify that the disinfection point exists and is functional and has the necessary required supplies (water, soap, alcohol, hypochlorite).

2. Verify that when external personnel enter the plant, they comply with the minimum hand washing protocols.

3. List, isolate and report suspected cases of COVID-19 using communication channels for notification to the competent health authorities.

4. Communicate to collaborators the procedures established by the authorities and the SG-SST area in the event of suspected cases of COVID-19.

5. Apply protocols, procedures and guidelines in relation to the preparation, response and care of cases of illness by COVID-19.

6. Disseminate information to employees about the generalities and guidelines given by the company area and the Ministry of Health and Protection in relation to alarm symptoms, guidelines and protocols for preparation and response to the eventual introduction of COVID-19 cases. 19.

7. Verify that collaborators properly use personal protection elements.

8. Verify that the cleaning, prevention and self-care measures are complied with in the ORDER OF DISCALCED CARMELITES - HOSPEDERÍA DURUELO.

9. Train collaborators in the correct washing of hands, disinfection and frequency of the same.

10. Verify that work surfaces are kept clean.

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11. Carry out the dissemination of official information on COVID-19 published by the Ministry of Health and Social Protection.

12. Socialize and communicate to all personnel within the scope, this action plan on the measures.

13. The PPE (Personal Protection Elements) will be delivered based on the hazard matrix, which is defined according to the level of risk and activities of each of the collaborators. The use, change and final disposal of the elements will be carried out according to the specifications given in the technical sheet that must be delivered by the manufacturers.

14. The company recommends that all its collaborators download and use the CoronApp APP.

COLLABORATORS:

1. Comply with the measures adopted by the company Order of Discalced Carmelites - Duruelo Inn.

2. Attend all training scheduled by the company and put the guidelines given into practice.

3. Use personal protection elements and be responsible for their proper use.

4. Take care of your health (self-care) and provide clear, truthful and complete information on your health status.

5. Inform when there is suspicion of contagion of the COVID -19 virus.

6. Keep frequently used areas, elements, equipment, tools (surfaces) clean and disinfected.

7. Maintain a minimum distance of two meters with internal and external personnel of the organization.

8. Keep distance from surfaces where external personnel have been while they are not disinfected.

9. The report of the health conditions by the collaborators must be made through the Human Resources office via WhatsApp 3138161914.

6. NATIONAL RESPONSE TO COVID-19 INFECTION.

The response is divided into different levels of action based on the company's risk and its impact on the health of the employees who work there. For the risk assessment, the characteristics of the agent and its ability to spread, the vulnerability of the population, the geographical extension (surrounding municipalities such as: Arcabuco, Sáchica, Ráquira, Samaca and Cucaita) and the commercial connections with the town are taken into account.

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According to the risk assessment for COVID-19, the response is classified into three levels:

6.1. FIRST LEVEL: RISK IDENTIFICATION AND DIAGNOSIS.

Taking into account the different types of threat identified in the company Orden de Carmelitas Descalzos - Hospederia Duruelo, the degree of risk to which employees are exposed in the event of an adverse event depends on the combination of two factors: Threats and vulnerability.

The response corresponds to this level of preparation, development of security protocols, includes dissemination activities and staff communication.

6.2. VULNERABILITY ASSESSMENT.

- Vulnerability corresponds to the degree of preparation for the event itself that may occur, and is carried out in operational-administrative relation, resources and processes, the degree of vulnerability is defined for each of them as follows:
 - ÿ The company's staff has organization, training and provision for attention to these events
 - $\ddot{\text{y}}$ The processes evaluate the capacity to respond to the activation of the plan.

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6.3. PREVENTION AND CONTROL MEASURES.


The following measures must be implemented for the prevention and identification of a possible case, these control components must be incorporated as part of the company's standard precautions.

The staff as well as their partners (families) must be able to apply the basic prevention and control measures of the COVID-19 virus correctly and consciously in accordance with the guidelines of the Ministry of Labour, Health and Social Protection.

6.3.1. FREQUENT HAND WASHING: WITH WATER, SOAP AND ANTIBACTERIAL.



JUSTIFICATION: Soap and antibacterial gel were adequate in the bathroom facilities. To prevent employees from handling money, contact with people, handling and contact with body fluids, they are provided with nitrile gloves.

- We will promote physical distancing with people outside the houses and face to face with other people in public places such as elevators, gatehouse, among others.
- In the applicable areas, distances of 1 meter1 will be maintained in work areas, rows or chairs.
- We promote that non-work activities do not coincide with hours of greater influx of public.





• Each worker will report their symptoms; If you have symptoms of COVID-19, you must stay home, notify your EPS and inform your immediate boss.

13. PROCEDURE IN THE FACE OF A POSSIBLE CASE OF COVID-19 (Route of E S Notification)

It is important to carry out timely verification and confirmation of collaborators with a history of direct or indirect contact, with suspected or confirmed cases of COVID-19, they must comply with isolation at home for 7 days, seek medical attention with the EPS. Monitor the collaborator to validate their health status.

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LEVELS OF INTERVENTION:

1. WORKER WITH MILD TO MODERATE SYMPTOMS OF ACUTE RESPIRATORY INFECTION (ARI), WITHOUT HAVING HAD CONTACT WITH PEOPLE DIAGNOSED WITH COVID-19:

It is recommended that the Worker stay home and contact their EPS. The EPS may:

- to. Isolate the Collaborator for 7 days.
- b. Give you Telephone Recommendations.
- b. Carry out Home Medical Consultation.
- c. Appointment to Priority Medical Consultation in an IPS.

The Worker must adopt special hygiene measures at home, frequently wash their hands, wear a mask and keep the area well ventilated.

You must be aware of the evolution of your symptoms, as well as your temperature identified with a thermometer, and inform the EPS if more serious signs appear.

2. WORKER WITH SEVERE SYMPTOMS OF Anger (PERSISTENT DOCUMENTED FEVER OVER 38°C AND SIGNS OF BREATHING DIFFICULTY), WITH CONTACT WITH A PERSON DIAGNOSED WITH COVID-19:

- b. Home Medical Consultation.
- c. Appointment to Priority Medical Consultation in an IPS.

The worker may be hospitalized or receive treatment at home. If the latter happens, you must strictly comply with medical recommendations and adopt special hygiene measures at home, frequently wash your hands, wear a face mask, keep a distance between family members (1 meter) and keep the area well ventilated.

Likewise, you must notify the Company and send the Medical Incapacity. The person in charge of the Occupational Health and Safety Management System of the Company will coordinate the identification of all the collaborators who were in contact with the worker and will inform (with prior informed consent) the Ministry of Health and Social Protection and the Secretary of Health, the name of the affected worker and the contacts with other people with whom he/she interacted, attaching the cell phone numbers and email. These agencies will continue to monitor exposed individuals.

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3. COLLABORATOR DIAGNOSED WITH COVID-19:

The collaborator must notify the Company and send the Medical Disability to the Human Management area who will inform the leader of the SG SST who will coordinate the identification of all the collaborators who were in contact with the patient and will inform (prior informed consent) to the Ministry of Health and Social Protection and the Secretary of Health, the name of the affected collaborator and the contacts with other people with whom he/she interacted, attaching the cell phone numbers and email. These organisms will continue to monitor exposed persons and the company must abide by all the recommendations issued by them.

In the event that the collaborator shows any symptoms during their working day, they will be isolated, following the guidelines established by the Ministry of Health.

Depending on the clinical picture (asymptomatic worker; or worker with mild, moderate or severe symptoms), he or she may be hospitalized or receive treatment at home. If the latter happens, you must strictly comply with medical recommendations and adopt special hygiene measures in your home, wash your hands frequently, wear a mask and keep the area well ventilated.

14. PENALTIES TO COLLABORATORS FOR BREACH OF THE PREVENTION MEASURES AGAINST THE COVID-19 VIRUS.

Taking into consideration the preventive health measures adopted by the Ministry of Health and Social Protection and in compliance with circular 003 of January 12, 2022, Requirement of a COVID-19 vaccination scheme for workers in productive sectors open to the public; Violation and non-observance of prevention measures will give rise to criminal and financial sanctions provided for in articles 368 of the penal code and 2.8.8.1.4.21 of Decree 780 of 2016, respectively.

15. COMMUNICATIONS PLAN:

Hospedería Duruelo will establish different information and communication channels to facilitate knowledge about occupational safety and health (OSH), prevention, self-care and management of the COVID-19 pandemic so that its employees are aware of the health conditions and security that must be assumed with total responsibility through healthy behaviors in the work, family and social environment.

In the same way, Hospedería Duruelo will maintain contact lines with the relevant authorities in case of any news or emergency.

16. WASTE MANAGEMENT.

Hospedería Duruelo is committed to guaranteeing comprehensive waste management through these actions:

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- Will make the disposal in bags and cans according to the color code.
- It will have a collection point, previously marked for later

collection and delivery for final disposal.

The handkerchiefs, personal protection elements, masks and disposable supplies that the staff use to comply with the "respiratory label" will be deposited in separate bins or containers, protected with lids, labeled and pedal-operated where possible.

• Trash pickup is done daily.

• Hazardous waste will be stored in a specific area, in a red bag, and then delivered to the management company.

17. EVALUATION, IMPROVEMENT AND MONITORING OF THE PROTOCOL FOR PREVENTION AND PROTECTION AGAINST BIOLOGICAL HAZARD CAUSED BY CORONAVIRUS COVID-19.

18. The evaluation of the prevention and protection protocol against biological danger due to coronavirus covid-19. It will be in charge of: Manager, Deputy Manager, Management Systems Manager, Head of Human Management, Head of Maintenance, Head of Accommodation, Head of Food and Beverages, to determine improvements, awareness actions, training, feedback and follow-up; The custody and archiving of the documented information must be guaranteed.
